Are you passionate about the learning and teaching of mathematics? Would you like to live in a beautiful historical city, with one of the most vibrant cultures in Europe? How about learning in small, lively classes where instructors challenge each student to deeply engage with the material?

**Budapest Semesters in Mathematics Education (BSME)** is a study abroad program in Budapest, Hungary, designed for those interested in the learning and teaching of secondary mathematics. At BSME, students explore the *Hungarian approach*, in which a strong emphasis is placed on problem solving, mathematical creativity, and communication.

BSME welcomes students who are (1) currently pursuing secondary mathematics teaching license at their home institutions, (2) planning to pursue other paths to mathematics licensure, or (3) simply curious about learning and teaching of mathematics. Our courses are designed so that credits will be transferable to American colleges and universities.

BSME is currently accepting applications for Summer 2019 (due March 1), Fall 2019 (due April 1), and Spring 2020 (due Nov. 1). The applications are reviewed on a rolling basis, so we encourage you to apply early. More information, including the online application, can be found at <u>bsmeducation.com</u>.
